Implementing a SYNODAL WAY of Proclaiming Christ and God's Kingdom

Synod Implementation in the Roman Catholic Diocese of Saskatoon was recently launched by Bishop Hagemoen.

"The Church's vocation and prophetic service (Lumen Gentium Dogmatic Constitution on the Church LG 12) consists in witnessing to God's plan to unite all humanity to Himself in freedom and communion. The Church is 'the Kingdom of Christ already present in mystery' (LG 3) and 'the seed and the beginning of the Kingdom on earth'(LG 5). It, therefore, walks together with all humanity, strongly committed to justice and peace, human dignity,and the common good. All this, while it 'aspires after the completion of the kingdom' (LG 5) when God will be 'all in all.' (1 Cor. 15: 28)."
